Luton Airport Firestation

The 500m² fire station floor at Luton Airport had been slowly deteriorating over recent years. The airport Service Manager recognised the problem and knew what was required moving forward:



We specified Vuba-Ultracoat, without any hesitation. Its attractive gloss finish with high build strength and abrasion resistance make this industrial epoxy floor coating a winning choice. With any floor coating job, there's a good degree of preparation required, which is always key. In this case, besides the initial grinding of the floor, a significant amount of time would be allowed for the demarcation and line marking requirements.



The old floor paint had not lived up to the test; we need a product that will put up with the wear and tear of heavy traffic and machinery. Without a floor paint that lasts, the all-important demarcation soon disappears and the floor becomes unattractive and dirty very quickly.

Once prepared, the Vuba Flooring team mixed and applied the two part epoxy floor coating over a period of three days to allow for the colour differences between walkways and the truck bays.



With the main floor coating complete, all that was left was to apply the white line markings with Vuba-Coat Epoxyline, a much thicker version of Ultracoat designed specifically for long lasting demarcation. The Service Manager was thrilled with the results, stating that the new floor had 'exceeded expectations' and given them something to be proud of for years to come.
